Job description

To recognise, promote and manage personal development opportunities for coaches

To encourage all coaches within the club to become formally qualified

To identify potential coaches to fill coaching posts within the club

To promote the RFU Code of Conduct for Coaches and/or develop an aligned club policy

To seek support from, and keep in contact with, coaching personnel within the RFU, the CB and scUK

Promote the image of the club.

To report to Club Captain

To liaise with Youth/Junior managers

You will attend relevant courses for your age group including two initial mandatory courses:

- Play it safe including online concussion pre-requisite (<http://www.englandrugbyfiles.com/concussion/courses/coaches/>)
- Rugby Ready (not online)
- Plus an optional first aid course

You will liaise with co-ordinators, safeguarding officers etc... when necessary.
